How was the Green Ontario Fund formed?

2015

- **Ontario's Climate Change Strategy**

vision and path to a prosperous, low-carbon society where greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction is part of Ontario's growth, efficiency and productivity

2016

- **5-year Climate Change Action Plan**

part of the Strategy, committed to creating a new agency (to become Green Ontario Fund) to use a portion of proceeds from ON's cap and trade program to increase use of low-carbon technologies

2017

- **Green Ontario Fund**

mandated to stimulate development of industry, trades and business undertakings that further deployment of technology to reduce GHG emissions from buildings or from the production of goods

GreenON Rebates Program



- Significant rebates for insulation, windows, and heat pumps

Insulation Rebates




- **\$1/ft² for attics**
 - Cap \$1,500
- **\$2/ft² for walls**
 - Exterior— cap \$3,800
 - Basement — cap \$1,900

Window Rebates


- \$500/rough opening up to 10 rough openings per home for high efficiency windows (\$5000 max rebate)

Heat Pump Rebates

- Air source: ducted and ductless, and cold climate
 - \$1900-\$5800 depending on type and configuration
- Ground source: horizontal, pond, or vertical loop
 - \$2000-\$20,000 depending on type and configuration



How to participate



- Work with a Participating Contractor for an eligible project
- Contractor sends the application
- Rebate cheque in 8-12 weeks

Requirements for all Participating Contractors

- An HST registration number
- Either a Master Business License or Articles of Incorporation valid for at least the past two years
- \$2 million in liability insurance
- \$1 million in automotive insurance
- A letter of clearance from WSIB (not required for sole proprietor)
- Review program orientation (free, available online—general and measure-specific)
- Sign the Contractor Participation Agreement
- + Product-specific certification/training
